## 3,000 Enthusiasts Gathered At The Ultimate Lifestyle Event

The Mercedes-Benz McLaren SLR was also showcased and the fourth annual Historics Run to The Quail, featuring 25 sport-racing cars from 1947-1955, was a highlight not to be missed.
